

I pledge to help Philadelphia vote on May 15th.

27,000 Philadelphians signed a petition calling for a vote on whether to have a 1500-foot buffer zone between casinos and homes, schools and places of worship. The Philadelphia City Council voted unanimously to place this referendum, Question #1, on the May 15th ballot.

The state Supreme Court is threatening our right to vote on the casino buffer zone. While we continue our fight to keep Question #1 on the May 15th ballot, no matter what the Court decides we plan on holding our own election so that Philadelphians will be able to vote on Question # 1 on May 15th. In order to do this we need your support.

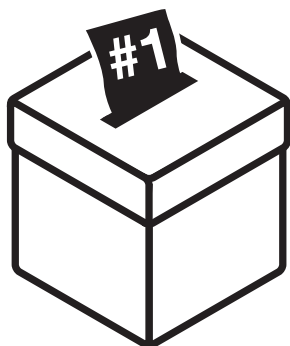
